What a blessing it is to proclaim God's message! On each of the four Sundays of October, I preached in a different city. In order, they were Hutt City, Wellington, Porirua, and Hawke's Bay. I'm thankful to those who invited me to do so. Perhaps it was really just preparation for December and January, where we will be in a different city almost every Sunday (sometimes more than one!). Starting 7 December, and for the following four Sundays, I am scheduled to speak in four different *states*!

The Hawke's Bay church is primarily made up of Samoans, some of which do not speak English (at least very well). I taught a Bible class on the Kingdom of God and a sermon on 1 Timothy 2:3-4, both of which brother Joe Tafunai translated into Samoan. This was my second time ever working with a translator, and it was a pleasure.

ONGOING STUDIES

For a few weeks, I was getting concerned that our studies with Alyssa would fade away. She was getting busy with her children and work, and she missed four studies in a row. We're thankful, though, that we were able to start them back up last week, and they've been going well. In fact, I think her interest and dedication have grown. We just finished a two-session study on biblical repentance.

Tusi's crew keeps going strong. On Tuesdays, we continue to study Christian discipleship. On Thursdays, we are studying the basics of the gospel and salvation with non-Christians being present almost every time.

The Porirua church was able to reach out to a family that was struggling financially. We met them through a local Christian. Helping them opened up a door for the gospel. We pray that we will see them again soon and maybe even engage in Bible study.

For the past several weeks, I have been going out to the Saturday market and engaging in spiritual conversations with strangers. It has been causing me to step out of my comfort zone, and I've been really enjoying it. I have made a lot of new positive acquaintances.

CHURCH UPDATES

Barry Hatcher was recently in New Zealand to promote the Fishers of Men program. If the Lord wills, he will be coming back to NZ from January to March 2016 to teach FOM to at least five different congregations. We are excited about it in the Wellington area, and though it is over a year away, some Christians have already signed up for it.

Rod Kyle, an evangelist who works with a few congregations in NZ recently came back from a very successful campaign in the Solomon Islands. In a matter of a few weeks, about a dozen souls were baptized, and a new congregation was established. Rod helps local Christians in the Solomons and trains them for evangelism and leadership. He reported his work to the Porirua church, and it looks like we may become involved in supporting an evangelist in going back to his family village to teach the gospel to the people he grew up with.

Silas has been growing before our very eyes! He's nearly four months old. He recently started rolling over and turning around. He might be an early crawler!

If the Lord wills, we will be in Tennessee this time next month. Please be praying for us as we prepare for our journey. It's been nearly 2 and a half years since we've been in the States. We're very excited to see our family, but our excitement cannot compete with Silas' grandparents' anticipation to meet their new grandson.
