**HOUSE AND RESIDENCY**

Some other exciting news is that we have purchased a house in Porirua! That might make you think right away that we have been granted residency. However, we have not yet. We have spoken with our immigration officer, and she seems to indicate that it will all go through fine, but there are no guarantees yet. She is waiting on a few more documents to come in from the government. Once they do, she will be able to present us with the initial assessment. With your prayers, we believe it will all work out fine. In addition, Westpac, one of the leading banks here, has agreed to finance us for the house, though we do not officially have residency yet.

The exchange rate from USD to NZD has gone about 20% in our favour in the past few months, which has allowed us to obtain our downpayment much faster. We are thankful that we no longer will be throwing away the Lord's money in rent. Thank you all for your prayers and help regarding the house. We pray daily that it will be used for God's glory.

**CONCLUSION**

Overall, our family is doing well, though we have all been battling a cold. Silas has also been suffering with an ear infection. We believe we are all on the mend. Silas is growing and learning so much every day. He is getting daring on his feet. He's figuring out this standing thing, though he prefers crawling. We all prefer what we're already comfortable and confident with, right? There's a lesson in that.
